We played 9 games in total, each lasting 8 minutes. We started well drawing against our first two opponents and then managed a 1-0 victory over Smannell Primary. From then on it was a mixed bag, winning two more games and losing four. Overall we finished 6th in the group out of 10 teams. In each game we showed determination and left the tournament with our heads high.

Congratulations to Hale Primary for winning the competition for the second year in a row and to our old rivals, North Waltham, for coming second.
