Dear parents, carers and members of our school community

I hope you all had a lovely Christmas holiday and that the new year is treating you well so far. We are looking forward to 2019 being as productive as ever.

On behalf of the staff I would like to say a huge thank you for all the kind gifts, cards and messages we received at the end of last term. We never expect them but very much appreciate them all.

A reminder that in my absence on the days at I am at Sparsholt, Mrs Smith is the person you should speak to if you require a senior member of staff. All class teachers are usually available after school or appointments can be made through the school office.

One of our pupils, Amelia in Beech Class, is raising money for charity. WINTER WEATHER
