WINTER WEATHER

Please ensure that your child brings a coat to school every day during the remaining winter months.

STAFFING

As usual in the spring term we will be having a student from Winchester University working with us on their final placement. Lucy Ventham will be teaching and supporting in Willow Class from 16 January. Also, Chlöe Warren, a School's Direct Student, will be carrying out a 6-week placement in Oak Class. Having student teachers as well as our regular staff will enable us to provide even more additional support for key children and groups.

Just a reminder that although the school has no deputy Headteacher, the most senior member of staff in my absence is Mrs Smith. My other senior managers are Miss Copping and Mrs Nicholson.

THE GOVERNORS

The Governing Body would like to thank Mr Rob Gray for his service as school governor. Due to work commitments Rob has resigned as a parent governor. This means that we now have a vacancy for a parent governor and a letter of information will be sent out early next week.

In looking to fill this vacancy the governors of the school have identified the following skills, experience and attributes that they feel would help strengthen the governing body:

The Governing Body meet regularly as Curriculum Committee and Finance and Personnel Committee and the Full Governing Body to act as 'critical friend' to Mr Davies, assist in setting the budget with the skills of Mrs Spencer to help us, discussing the application and monitoring of the school improvement plan with the help of the subject coordinators and a myriad of other things.
