BRIGHTON HILL COMMUNITY SCHOOL

You may have heard already but I am still delighted to tell you that Brighton Hill Community School were graded 'Good' in their recent Ofsted inspection.

Over the past few years the school has struggled with numbers and staffing but under new management from Headteacher, Mr Edwards and his leadership team, the school is going from strength to strength. I have met with Mr Edwards on several occasions since his appointment in January and he has also met the children in Year 4 and 5. He has already made a significant difference to morale and learning at the school and Brighton Hill fully deserves this recognition from Ofsted

The school had lost its popularity with Cliddesden parents of late but I urge you now to consider Brighton Hill as one of your choices when thinking about the next stage of education for your children. Remember, whether you have made your choice or not, it is important to visit as many schools as possible before applying to secondary school.

As Brighton Hill is our catchment school, I will be inviting Mr Edwards in to school in September to speak to the current Year 5 parents who will then be applying for secondary school places.

Children attending sports club must have a PE kit to take part. If they do not have a PE kit for the club they will not be permitted to take part and parents will be contacted to collect their child from school.

SAFEGUARDING BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL

I must remind parents and carers that for health and safety reasons they must supervise their children in the playground after school. Recently Mr Sumner and I have had to stop younger children from standing on and jumping from the seats in the School Garden after school. Most schools have a policy where parents have to collect their children and leave the premises immediately. We however, allow our families to stay on site up till 3:45pm as I know some of you like to enjoy the community feel and beautiful surroundings which we are proud of, but please adhere to our safety rules.

Please also note that only staff should arrive at school before 8:15am. Children and parents should not enter the playground <u>until 8:15am</u> when a member of staff is on duty, due to the bus arriving, unless they attend before school activities (e.g. wake-up club or OT) or have made special arrangements with the school.
