ATTENDANCE POLICY

I wish to remind you that holidays taken in term time cannot be authorised and may occur a fine. Hampshire County Council and school policy now states that if the unauthorised absence is for 10 or more sessions (5 days) in any 100 possible school sessions then a penalty notice for non-attendance will be issued.

Leave for exceptional circumstances may be authorised under my discretion. If you wish to make a request for term time leave for your child you must complete the request form and a meeting may be held to discuss the application. MORNING TIMES

Please do not arrive at school before 8:15am. The playground is staffed from 8:15am in the morning, the office from 8:30am. Willow and Beech classes <u>only</u> are open at 8:30am. Registration is from 8:45 to 8:55am. Lessons start promptly after registration. Should you wish to speak to a teacher please do so arrange an appointment with the office or see them in the playground after school. The link door will be closed after the children have been escorted to the playground at the end of the day. If you or your child needs to re-enter the building please ask a member of staff or call in at reception. All these measures are for the children's safety and I thank you for your co-operation.

SCHOOL DINNERS

Just to remind parents of children in Willow and Beech classes that all children in EYFS and Key Stage 1 are entitled to a fee school meal. The cost of a meal is £2.15 for children in Key Stage 2 which we still feel is good value for money. Please ensure school dinner money is paid in advance at the school office, cheques payable to $^{\prime}HCC^{\prime}$ Please check the dinner menu in virtual office on our website.

CHARITY FUNDRAISING EVENTS

This term we have two fundraising events for charity. The first is our 'African Welly Walk' on Friday 6th October. All the children will be walking in their wellington boots to Farleigh church via The Drove and back to school along the fields. This is about a 2-mile walk. We ask that all children bring in a suggested £2 donation for this event but please give whatever you can spare. All the money raised will go to African farmers to give their children a better start in life and this will be our harvest event this year, replacing the harvest sale. We would love parents to volunteer to join us if they can spare the time. Please contact the office if you can volunteer.

The second event on November 23rd is a sponsored sports circuit. A member of the GB athletics team will be visiting the school to lead the event and meet the children. 60% of the funds raised will go to the school and we will spend it all on sports equipment and opportunites. The other 40% goes to providing funding for young athletes around the country. Further details will be sent out later this half of term.
