Dear parents, carers and members of our school community

A warm welcome back to the start of a new academic year at Cliddesden Primary School. I hope you all had an enjoyable summer. All the children have settled in well to their classes and are ready for the new academic year. Next week we welcome our new early years (EYFS) children and their families.

ATTENDANCE POLICY

Our overall attendance last year dropped by 1%. Analysis show that more holidays during term time were taken. I wish to remind you that holidays taken in term time may not be authorised and may occur a fine. Hampshire County Council and school policy now states that if the unauthorised absence is for 10 or more sessions (5 days) in any 100 possible school sessions then a penalty notice for non-attendance will be issued. In order to raise our attendance figures the governing body and I will be taking on a stricter stance to discourage children taking term time holidays.

Leave for exceptional circumstances may be authorised under the Headteacher's discretion. If you wish to make a request for term time leave for your child you must complete the request form and a meeting may be held to discuss the application. PE

Please note the days your child has PE this half of term

Willow - Mondays and Fridays Beech - Mondays and Fridays Chestnut - Wednesdays and Fridays Oak - Tuesdays and Fridays

Please ensure your child has full PE kit on those days. PE is a curriculum statutory requirement and children who forget their kits will be sent a letter home. Some lessons are outside. Cliddesden PE hoodies are part of the school PE kit and all pupils are required to have one. They are available from Tesco and Skoolkit.

Please note that earrings are not part of school uniform and generally are not encouraged in primary school age pupils. During PE lessons earrings need to be removed.

If your child has earrings (studs) then please ensure they have some micropore tape in their PE kit bag so they can tape their ears for PE lessons OR have a small envelope/jewellery box in which to store their earrings during PE lessons.

MORNING TIMES REMINDER

Please do not arrive at school before 8:15am. The playground is staffed from 8:15am in the morning, the office from 8:30am. Please remember that it is a good will measure to staff the playground from 8:15am and not a statutory requirement. On occasion there may be a reason for the staff member on duty to be a little late getting out. If this is the case you should remain with your child. Willow and Beech classes only are open at 8:30am. Registration is from 8:45 to 8:55am. Lessons start promptly after registration. Should you wish to speak to a teacher please do arrange an appointment with the office or see them in the playground after school. The link door will be closed after the children have been escorted to the playground at the end of the day. If you or your child needs to re-enter the building please ask a member of staff or call in at reception. All these measures are for the children's safety and I thank you for your co-operation.

SCHOOL DINNERS

Lunches made by our Cook, Mrs Hardy, are free to Reception and KS1 pupils (Willow and Beech classes) but from 06/09/19 will cost £2.40 per meal. Dinner money should be paid on the day the meal is taken or in advance. If your account is more than 1 week in arrears, a school lunch may not be provided until the debt is cleared. Cash or cheques (payable to HCC) are the only method of payment - these should be brought to the school office and placed in the red box just inside the office door or given to the class teacher to be placed in the register and sent to the office. Please state clearly on the outside of the envelope or the back of the cheque the name of child, amount enclosed and 'lunches'.

MEDICATION IN SCHOOL

If your child requires prescribed medicine including inhalers or epi-pens, please ensure these are brought into the school office and all paperwork completed. Thank you.

There are a number of important letters that will be sent out next week in hard copy. One is the Home School Agreement that needs to be signed annually. Please ensure that all the signed documents are returned to the school office as soon as possible. Thank you for your cooperation.
