Dear Parents and members of the school community,

I hope you had a very enjoyable summer. I am sure you are eager to have your children return to school on Monday!

Today and tomorrow the staff are in school preparing the school for the new academic year and completing annual training in safeguarding and other items.

I have included a reminder of the staffing for this year below. This year Mrs Hussey is completing her final route into being a qualified teacher and will be working in Chestnut class as a trainee teacher. Having been a HLTA at our school for the past 3 years we know that she is already very competent in the classroom. Initially, she will share the class with Miss Haresign but as the year progresses she will have greater responsibility in the class, which will allow Miss Haresign to work across Key Stage 2 and share her expertise accordingly.

We are pleased to tell you that Debs Costen will be continuing her PE role in school this year. However, her days have changed. She will be working with Beech and Chestnut classes on a Thursday morning and Oak and Willow on a Friday morning. Children should come to school in PE kit on their 'Debs Day'. On the other day that the children have PE, which is a shorter session, children should bring their kit in to change into. Teachers will inform you of this day next week. Wake-Up club will resume on Fridays at 8am and details will be sent out early next week.

Before the holidays we sent out booking details for our Premier Education after-school sports clubs and also Streetdance. We have sent them again today. All clubs are run by professional coaches. For the clubs to run they need to have sufficient numbers, so please sign up if your child is interested. For children in Years 5 and 6 who wish to be considered for the school Tag Rugby and Football teams, attending the relevant club is highly beneficial.

A reminder that if you are unemployed or on a lower income, your child may be eligible for free school meals and pupil premium funding. Please contact the office if you are unsure.

We look forward to welcoming your children back to school on Monday and we welcome our new Foundation Stage starters on Tuesday. Please note that school starts promptly at 8:45am with registration. Arrivals after 8:50am will be regarded as late. This is to comply with the new DfE school day requirements.
