Dear Parents and members of the school community,




Yesterday we celebrated world book day at Cliddesden. Once again, the children came to school dressed as either a book character or someone/thing from a non-fiction book. This year we even had a dinosaur! Thank you to all our parents for helping your children make such a brilliant effort.

The day included book themed activities, a special assembly where some of the children got to show off their costumes and talk about their books. Oak class 'buddied up' with Beech to read some stories and I visited the classes to do a bit of performance poetry.

Reading is a vital part of primary education and days like this help promote literacy and the pleasure that we can get from reading books.

Last week Oak and Chestnut classes visited the Southampton City Art Gallery. While there, they participated in an Art workshop where they made faces and human figures using wire and pipe cleaners.

They also had a tour of some of the more significant pieces in the collection: a portrait by Gainsborough, 'The Diver' by Antony Gormley, François-Pascal-Simon Gérard's portrait of Napoleon and a 14th Century triptych painted using tempera.





After a brief lunch, they had time to explore the gallery more before returning to school. Our guides, Ali and Lisa, were very informative and the children learnt lots from them.
